We are pleased to inform you that the school is organising **SPOTLIGHT'22**- The Inter-house Talent Hunt with the aim of nurturing the artistic talents of the students. This Cultural Festival will be held from **6th to 8th September 2022** and the competitions in various events will be conducted for students of all sections (from classes I to XII) in the morning and evening hours. The preliminary round competitions will be held in the last week of August and the details of the competitions will be intimated to the participants accordingly. *Kindly note that all the competitions will be conducted physically.*

Students who wish to participate should fill in the attached **Google Form** and submit the same latest by **21st Aug 2022**. The students shall be divided into categories based on the classes - **Kids** (Classes 1 & 2), **Sub Junior** (Classes 3 & 4), **Junior** (Classes 5 & 6), **Intermediate** (Classes 7, 8 & 9) and **Senior** (Classes 10, 11 & 12).

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- *All the competitions will be held inter-house*
- *A student can take part max. in **5 events- 3 individual items and 2 group items***
- *Religious songs should not be sung or played for any item.*
- *All literary competitions will be in **English***
- *The contestants should strictly adhere to the timing in their respective events.*
- *If there are less than three entries in any event they may be allowed to participate in the higher category.*
- *In group events, the minimum number of participants is 5 and the maximum is 10.*
- *However, the date or time will not be changed at the participant's convenience.*

RULES FOR ALL EVENTS

ACTION SONG (KIDS)

1. Duration is 2 Minutes.
2. Rhymes are allowed with action but songs from movies are not allowed.
3. Rendering should be from the memory.
4. Using props will be an additional advantage.
5. The competition will be judged on the basis of song selection, performance, confidence, rhythm & tone quality.

FANCY DRESS (KIDS)

1. Duration is 30 Seconds.
2. Face should not be covered.
3. The introduction is a must and the lines must be short and should provide accurate information.
4. The competition will be judged based on costume, confidence, novelty and creativity.

SOLO DANCE (KIDS)

1. Duration is 2 Minutes.
2. Contestants may choose either a Cinematic or Western dance.
3. Performance should not exceed 4 minutes.
4. Judgment will be based on coordination, costumes, song selection, style and overall performance.
5. Film songs are permitted. However, the lyrics should not carry any indecent/objectionable meanings

DRAWING & PAINTING COMPETITION

1. Drawing sheet will be provided. Participants must bring their own drawing tools.
2. The topic for the Art Competition will be announced 2 days before the competitions.
3. The size of the artwork must be A4 size.
4. Duration for Sub Junior and Junior is 1 hr. and for Intermediate and senior 2 hrs.
5. The competition will be judged based on creativity, Image quality, neatness and overall presentation

POEM RECITATION

1. Time limit is 4 minutes.
2. The poem must be between 15 and 30 lines.
3. The Poem should be a single unit, not selected from a part or a few lines from a poem or poems.
4. A short introduction about the poem that includes the name of the poem and the poet should be given.
5. Poems must be recited from memory and participants are not allowed to refer to any notes or printed materials during the presentation.
6. The competition will be judged based on clarity, expression, rhythm, tone & general impression.

STORYTELLING

1. Time limit is 4 minutes.
2. Contestants can tell any story such as Historical tales, Family stories, Moral Story, Folklores etc.
3. The presentation must be memorized and not allowed to use the text of the story.
4. The presentation must be delivered only in English.
5. The competition will be judged based on content, plot, grammar, pronunciation & presentation.

ELOCUTION

1. The speech may not exceed 4 minutes in duration.
2. The speaker is expected to memorize their speech and is not allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes, or cards.
3. Points will be awarded based on content, clarity of message, language and presentation
4. The topic will be announced 2 days before the competition.

EXTEMPORE

1. The speech may not exceed 3 minutes in duration.
2. The speaker is expected to memorize their speech and is not allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes, or cards.
3. Points will be awarded based on content, clarity of message, language and presentation.
4. The topic will be announced 15 minutes before the competition.

CLASSICAL MUSIC

1. Time limit is 6 minutes.
2. The contestants are allowed to use tamera or sruthi box.
3. Judgment will be based on the qualities like swara, taala, composition, general impression etc.

LIGHT MUSIC

1. For Light Music-Indian, Song in any Indian language is allowed.
2. Time limit is 4 minutes
3. Karaoke or musical accompaniment is allowed
4. Film songs are permitted. However, the lyrics should not carry any indecent/objectionable meanings.
5. Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

1. Competition will be categorized into String, Percussion, Wind & Electronic if there are a sufficient number of contestants.
2. Time limit is 4 minutes.
3. For instrumental music (Keyboard), features like auto rhythm should not be used.
4. Judgment will be based on proficiency, rhythm, melody, tone & presentation.

MIMICRY/MIMICRY

1. Time limit is 4 minutes
2. Performance should be in English or in any one Indian language.
3. The actor has to play multiple roles/voices.
4. Obscenity of any kind is not allowed and will lead to immediate disqualification.
5. Performance will be judged on theme, acting, character, presentation & overall

CLASSICAL DANCE FOR GIRLS

1. Time limit is 8 minutes
2. Participants may choose any one of the following dance forms. (a) Bharatanatyam (b) Kuchipudi (c) Kathak (d) Odissi (e) Mohiniattam (f) Manipuri (g) Kathakali.
3. Judgment will be based on the qualities like Thala and Technique, rhythm, abhinaya or expression, appearance and general Impression.

FOLK DANCE FOR GIRLS (SOLO)

1. Time limit is 4 minutes
2. Film songs are allowed, however, the originality is to be preserved
3. Judgment will be based on rhythm, expression, choreography and presentation.

RANGOLI

1. The Maximum number of participants in a team is five.
2. Size of rangoli should be a maximum of 1 meter in Diameter (Circle) or Length (Square).
3. Time duration is 2 hours.
4. Participants have to bring their own materials. It can be sawdust, rice, pulses, holi colors, or flowers.
5. For decoration, additional material can be used.
6. The competition will be judged based on Design, Theme, Clarity , Colour combination & Materials used

GROUP SONG

1. Musical instruments are allowed for accompaniment.
2. Time limit is 4 minutes
3. A group shall comprise of minimum 5 (five) participants and a maximum 10 including musicians.
4. Karaoke track for the final is allowed
5. Judgment will be based on Pitch, Rhythm, Coordination, Harmony & Presentation

GROUP DANCE – FOLK (For Girls)

1. Team can perform a) Garba (b) Bhangra (c) Oppana (d) Gidda (e) Kolattam / Kolkali (f) Thiruvathira Kali (g) Margam Kali (h) Arabian Folk Dance, etc
2. Film songs are allowed, however, the originality is to be preserved
3. Time limit is 4 minutes
4. Judgment based on rhythm, formation, expression, costumes, makeup, coordination and overall performance

GROUP DANCE – Contemporary/Thematic (For Girls)

1. Set & Props can be used
2. Maximum number of participants is 15
3. Recorded audio track can be used
4. Judgment will be based on Theme, Choreography, Creativity, Originality, Teamwork & Theatrical Quality

TABLEAU (open)

1. The duration is 1 minute. 2 minutes will be given for stage preparation
2. In the scene, participants should remain motionless and silent.
3. Narration can be recorded or live.
4. Judgment will be based on Theme, Makeup & Costume, Clarity of Presentation and Overall

MIME (open)

1. Time limit is 3 minutes.
2. The act should not contain any dialogues, lip-sync or props
3. No act shall contain any offensive, obscene, disrespectful actions or gestures.
4. Points will be given on innovation, depiction of the situation, teamwork and expression.

ORCHESTRA – INSTRUMENTAL (Open)

1. Maximum number of participants is 7
2. The instruments should be played manually, No recorded tracks are allowed
3. Judgment will be based on Harmony, Rhythm, Coordination, Teamwork & Overall.
