The students shall be divided into categories based on their Grades: **Kids** (Grades I & II), **Sub Junior** (Grades III & IV), **Junior** (Grades V & VI), **Intermediate** (Grades VII, VIII & IX) and **Senior** (Grades X & XI).

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- *All competitions will be held inter-house.*
- *A student can participate in a maximum of **five** events: three individual items and two group items.*
- *In the open category, students can participate as a team regardless of their class, age, or house.*
- *Religious songs should not be sung or played for any item.*
- *Contestants must strictly adhere to the timing of their respective events.*
- *If there are fewer than three entries in any event, participants may be allowed to compete in the higher category.*
- *In group events, the minimum number of participants is five and the maximum is ten.*
- *For group events, a list including the group leader's and participants' names must be submitted to the teacher in charge.*
- *The date or time of events will not be changed for the participant's convenience.*

- *The decision of the judges will be final.*

RULES FOR THE EVENTS

ISLAMIC COMPETITION

1. Hifz (Half of 30th Chapter): Junior
2. Hifz (Complete 30th Chapter): Intermediate & Senior
3. Tajweed (Half of 30th Chapter): Sub Junior, Junior, Intermediate & Senior
4. Adhan: Junior, Intermediate & Senior

DRAWING & PAINTING COMPETITION

1. A drawing sheet will be provided. Participants must bring their own drawing tools.
2. The topic for the Art Competition will be announced 2 days before the competition.
3. The size of the artwork must be A4 size.
4. Duration for Sub Junior and Junior is 1 hr. and for Intermediate and Senior 2 hrs.
5. The competition will be judged based on creativity, Image quality, neatness and overall presentation

POEM RECITATION- English

1. The time limit is 4 minutes.
2. The poem must be between 15 and 30 lines.
3. The Poem should be a single unit, not selected from a part or a few lines from a poem or poems.
4. A short introduction about the poem that includes the name of the poem and the poet should be given.
5. Poems must be recited from memory and participants are not allowed to refer to any notes or printed materials during the presentation.
6. The competition will be judged based on clarity, expression, rhythm, tone & general impression.

POEM RECITATION- Arabic

1. The poem must be recited in Arabic only; translations are not allowed during the performance.
2. Time Limit: Each participant must complete the recitation within 3 to 5 minutes.
3. Reading from paper or device is not permitted; the poem must be recited from memory.
4. Judgement is based on Pronunciation & Clarity Expression, Fluency, Rhythm & Intonation

FANCY DRESS

1. The duration is 30 seconds.
2. The face should not be covered.
3. An introduction is mandatory, and the lines must be short and provide accurate information.
4. The competition will be judged based on costume, confidence, novelty, and creativity.

STORYTELLING

1. The time limit is 4 minutes.
2. Contestants can tell any story such as Historical tales, Family stories, Moral Stories, Folklores etc.
3. The presentation must be memorized and not allowed to use the text of the story.
4. The presentation must be delivered only in English.
5. The competition will be judged based on content, plot, grammar, pronunciation & presentation.

ELOCUTION

1. The speech may not exceed 4 minutes in duration.
2. The speaker is expected to memorize their speech and is not allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes, or cards.
3. Points will be awarded based on content, clarity of message, language and presentation
4. The topic will be announced 2 days before the competition.

EXTEMPORE

1. The speech may not exceed 3 minutes in duration.
2. The speaker is expected to memorize their speech and is not allowed to read any part of the speech from papers, notes, or cards.
3. Points will be awarded based on content, clarity of message, language and presentation.
4. The topic will be announced 15 minutes before the competition.

MAPPILAPATTU

1. Time limit is 4 minutes
2. The song must be a traditional or popular Mappilapattu
3. Karaoke or background music should not be used.
4. Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

LIGHT MUSIC-Indian

1. For Light Music-Indian, Song in any Indian language is allowed.
2. The time limit is 4 minutes
3. Karaoke or musical accompaniment is allowed
4. Film songs are permitted. However, the lyrics should not carry any indecent/objectionable meanings.
5. Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

LIGHT MUSIC-Western

1. For Light Music-Western, Only songs in English are allowed.
2. The time limit is 4 minutes
3. Karaoke or musical accompaniment is permitted.
4. The lyrics should not carry any indecent/objectionable meanings.
5. Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

1. The Competition will be categorized into String, Percussion, Wind & Electronic if there are a sufficient number of contestants.
2. The time limit is 4 minutes.
3. For instrumental music (Keyboard), features like auto rhythm should not be used.
4. Judgment will be based on proficiency, rhythm, melody, tone & presentation.

MIMICRY/MONOACT

1. The time limit is 4 minutes
2. Performance should be in English or in any one Indian language.
3. The actor has to play multiple roles/voices.
4. Obscenity of any kind is not allowed and will lead to immediate disqualification.
5. Performance will be judged on theme, acting, character, presentation & overall

GROUP SONG

1. Musical instruments are allowed for accompaniment.
2. The time limit is 4 minutes
3. A group shall comprise of minimum 5 (five) participants and a maximum of 10 including musicians.
4. The karaoke track for the final is allowed
5. Judgment will be based on Pitch, Rhythm, Coordination, Harmony & Presentation

FACE PAINTING

1. Each team must consist of three members – one model (whose face will be painted) and two artists (who will do the painting). Team members must remain the same throughout the competition.
2. Teams will be given a total of 60 minutes to complete the artwork.
Only non-toxic, skin-safe face paints are allowed. The use of stencils, glitter, stickers, or pre-made designs is strictly prohibited. Teams must bring their own painting materials unless informed otherwise.
3. The theme will be either announced in advance or revealed on the spot.
4. Judging will be based on creativity, relevance to the theme, neatness, and overall visual

MIME (open)

1. The time limit is 3 minutes.
2. The act should not contain any dialogues, lip-sync or props
3. No act shall contain any offensive, obscene, disrespectful actions or gestures.
4. Points will be given on innovation, depiction of the situation, teamwork and expression.

OPPANA / DAFF MUTTU / KOLKALI (open)

1. Each team should have a maximum of 10 members.
2. The performance time should be between 5 to 6 minutes.
3. Performers should adhere to the traditional style and rhythm of the chosen art form—Oppana, Daff Muttu, or Kolkali.
4. Use of original musical instruments (daf, etc.) is mandatory, and costumes should reflect the cultural authenticity.
5. Teams will be judged on coordination, rhythm, energy, synchronization of movements and claps, voice modulation, and overall stage presence.

DRAMA (open)

1. The duration of the performance should not exceed 10 minutes.
2. The script can be original or adapted appropriately and should convey a clear message.
3. Props and costumes are allowed but must be manageable and should not cause delays during setup.
4. The competition will be judged based on Acting skills, Dialogue delivery, Creativity, Teamwork and Costume and make up.
