JUNIOR SECTION

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- All competitions will be held inter-house.
- A student can participate in a maximum of *five* events: three individual items and two group items.
- Religious songs should not be sung or played for any item.
- Contestants must strictly adhere to the timing of their respective events.
- If there are fewer than three entries in any event, participants may be allowed to compete in the higher category.
- In group events, the minimum number of participants is five and the maximum is ten.
- For group events, a list including the group leader's and participants' names must be submitted to the teacher in charge.
- The date or time of events will not be changed for the participant's convenience.

- The decision of the judges will be final.

RULES FOR THE EVENTS

ACTION SONG (KIDS)

- 1. The duration is 2 minutes.
- 2. Rhymes with actions are allowed, but songs from movies are not permitted.
- 3. The rendering should be from memory.
- 4. The use of props will be an added advantage.
- 5. The competition will be judged based on song selection, performance, confidence, rhythm, and tone quality.

SOLO DANCE (KIDS)

- 1. The duration is 2 minutes.
- 2. Contestants may choose either a cinematic or Western dance.
- 3. The performance should not exceed 4 minutes.
- 4. Judgment will be based on coordination, costume, song selection, style, and overall performance.
- 5. Film songs are permitted; however, the lyrics should not contain any indecent or objectionable meanings.

SINGING (KIDS)

- 1. Any Song in any language is allowed.
- 2. The time limit is 3 minutes
- 3. Karaoke or musical accompaniment is allowed
- 4. Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

COLOURING COMPETITION (KIDS)

1.A colouring sheet will be provided. Participants must bring their own drawing tools.

- 2. The size of the artwork is A4 size.
- 3. Duration is 1 hr.
- 4. The competition will be judged based on creativity, Image quality, neatness and overall presentation

ISLAMIC COMPETITIONS

- 1. Hifz (Half of 30th Chapter)
- 2. Tajweed (Half of 30th Chapter)

FANCY DRESS

- 1. The duration is 30 seconds.
- 2. The face should not be covered.
- 3. An introduction is mandatory, and the lines must be short and provide accurate information.
- 4. The competition will be judged based on costume, confidence, novelty, and creativity.

DRAWING COMPETITION

1 A drawing sheet will be provided. Participants must bring their own drawing tools.

- 2. The topic for the Art Competition will be announced 2 days before the competition.
- 3. The size of the artwork must be A4 size.
- 4. Duration for Sub Junior is 1 hr.
- 5. The competition will be judged based on creativity, Image quality, neatness and overall presentation

POEM RECITATION

- 1. The time limit is 3 minutes.
- 2. The poem must be between 10 and 20 lines.
- 3. The Poem should be a single unit, not selected from a part or a few lines from a poem or poems.
- 4. A short introduction about the poem that includes the name of the poem and the poet should be given.
- 5. Poems must be recited from memory and participants are not allowed to refer to any notes or printed materials during the presentation.
- 6. The competition will be judged based on clarity, expression, rhythm, tone & general impression.

STORYTELLING

- 1. The time limit is 4 minutes.
- 2. Contestants can tell any story such as Historical tales, Family stories, Moral Stories, Folklores etc.
- 3. The presentation must be memorized and not allowed to use the text of the story.
- 4. The presentation must be delivered only in English.

5. The competition will be judged based on content, plot, grammar, pronunciation & presentation.

LIGHT MUSIC-Indian

1. For Light Music-Indian, Song in any Indian language is allowed.

- 2.The time limit is 3 minutes
- 3.Karaoke or musical accompaniment is allowed

4.Film songs are permitted. However, the lyrics should not carry any indecent/objectionable meanings.

5.Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

LIGHT MUSIC-Western

- 1. For Light Music-Western, Only songs in English are allowed.
- 2. The time limit is 3 minutes
- 3. Karaoke or musical accompaniment is permitted.
- 4. The lyrics should not carry any indecent/objectionable meanings.
- 5. Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

- 1. The Competition will be categorized into String, Percussion, Wind & Electronic if there are a sufficient number of contestants.
- 2. The time limit is 4 minutes.
- 3. For instrumental music (Keyboard), features like auto rhythm should not be used.
- 4. Judgment will be based on proficiency, rhythm, melody, tone & presentation.

MIMICRY/MONOACT

- 1. The time limit is 4 minutes
- 2. Performance should be in English or in any one Indian language.
- 3. The actor has to play multiple roles/voices.
- 4. Obscenity of any kind is not allowed and will lead to immediate disqualification.
- 5. Performance will be judged on theme, acting, character, presentation & overall

MAPPILAPATTU

- 1. Time limit is 4 minutes
- 2. The song must be a traditional or popular Mappilapattu
- 3. Karaoke or background music should not be used.

4.Judgment will be based on pitch, rhythm, lyrics & pronunciation, voice timbre & overall

FOLK DANCE (SOLO)

- 1. The time limit is 4 minutes
- 2. Film songs are allowed, however, the originality is to be preserved
- 3. Judgment will be based on rhythm, expression, choreography and presentation.

GROUP SONG

- 1. Musical instruments are allowed for accompaniment.
- 2. The time limit is 4 minutes
- 3. A group shall comprise of minimum 5 (five) participants and a maximum of 10 including musicians.
- 4. The karaoke track for the final is allowed
- 5. Judgment will be based on Pitch, Rhythm, Coordination, Harmony & Presentation

GROUP DANCE – FOLK

1. Team can perform a) Garba (b) Bhangra (c) Oppana (d) Gidda (e) Kolattam / Kolkali (f) Thiruvathira Kali (g) Margam Kali (h) Arabian Folk Dance, etc

2. Film songs are allowed, however, the originality is to be preserved

3. The time limit is 4 minutes

4. Judgment based on rhythm, formation, expression, costumes, makeup, coordination and overall performance
