The objective behind the carnival is to accommodate all enthusiastic students who wish to participate in cultural or thematic programs to showcase their talents. It is a school-wide program for both sessions, and it will be conducted as per these guidelines.

I. Cultural Programs and other activities will be divided among students into four categories

A) KG category, KG-1/KG2 B) Primary -Grades 1 to 4 C) Middle school-Grades 5 to 8, and

D) Secondary/Senior secondary -Grades 9 to 12.

II. All programs will be divided into:

1. Classical dances and folk dances are rooted in themes and cultural traditions. Movie songs are subject to approval by the screening committee.

2. Memes and skits **3.** Live music concert **4.** Talk shows **5.** Drama **6.** Stand-up comedy and any other solo performances like talk shows, mimicry and acrobatics, etc.

III. There are Four Venues to be dedicated to specified categories, and performances will be scheduled as per the number of registrations

- 1. Junior section indoor auditorium for primary student's 2. KG play area for KG students
- 3. Main stage for middle and secondary students. 4. A small stage (to be created in the BS assembly area)

IV. Formation of Committees: Different committees were formed to organise the event with coordination and support. You are requested to cooperate with the committee's requirements and provide all necessary support to ensure the event is a hassle-free experience.

Sponsorship: The school will invite sponsors to the programs to cover expenses and promote community participation through various activities. Staff must coordinate with the community to get the sponsorships.

Given the current student strength, it is only fair to give all enthusiasts a chance to participate in the events. All cultural events start at **6:00 PM and end at 9:30 PM**, so on each day, 3 hours and 30 minutes will be allocated to each category of students.

Hence, all class teachers are requested to identify the students in their respective classes and list them out for the performances. All guidelines regarding the selection process will be issued in due course. We appreciate your continued support and cooperation in this matter.
